

BOWEL SCREENING CAN SAVE YOUR LIFE.

Make sure you're around to be strong and healthy for your family.



The free bowel cancer screening test is easy, and can be done in the privacy of your own home.



GET IT

People aged 50 to 74 will receive a kit in the mail.



DO IT

The test is free and will take just a few minutes at two different times. So don't put it off until later – get it done.



POST IT

Return the kit in the mail using the envelope provided. You don't need stamps or to pay for postage.



DONE

The results will be sent to you and your doctor within two weeks.

Bowel cancer is the second most common cause of cancer deaths in Australia. But if it's found early, up to 90% of cases can be successfully treated. It's important you do the test, because there can often be no obvious signs that you have bowel cancer, and it can occur in people who have no family history.

The National Bowel Cancer Screening Program is expanding and by 2020 people aged 50-74 will receive a kit every two years.
